**PROGRAM DETAILS**

Heathridge Primary School has been awarded a \$5000 Sporting Schools Club Connect grant. This grant is to be used to provide after-school sports to the students from Heathridge Primary School. The aim of Club Connect is to support primary school students to transition from a school-based sporting program to participating at their local sporting club, promoting a lifelong engagement in sport.

In Term 2, we will be offering Tenpin Bowling Australia's internationally recognised 'learn to bowl' program, Bowl Patrol, to students from Year's 4 to 6. This 4-week skills program promotes learning through play and is very inclusive, so any student can pick up the skills to become a striking machine!

**TIMETABLE AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS**

The bowling sessions will take place on Tuesday afternoons, in Weeks 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Term 2. Sessions will run for 1 hour, commencing at approximately 3.00 pm and concluding by 4.00 pm. A bus will transfer the students to and from the venue. The bus will be departing Heathridge Primary School at 2.55 pm and taking the students to Zone Bowling, 1/23 Franklin Lane, Joondalup. The session will conclude at 4.00 pm and the bus will return to Heathridge Primary School. Students are expected to arrive back at school by 4.15 pm. If you wish to take your child/children home directly from the venue, please see the supervising teacher, to be signed out. If another adult is collecting your child, please provide a written permission letter. Any student not collected from Zone Bowling by 4.00 pm will automatically return to school on the bus.

**SELECTION FOR THE PROGRAM**

Up to 30 positions are available. To secure your child/children a position, please return this completed application form to the front office drop box before Thursday 26 May. If more than 30 students apply, then a ballot will take place to select students. Students who are selected will be notified and are required to complete a registration form. Late applications will only be considered if there are positions available.

All students will need to bring a water bottle, afternoon tea and socks. All students are to meet Mrs Sublet outside the Science Room at 2.50 pm.
