



INTERM SWIMMING LESSONS – TERM 2, 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

Interm swimming classes for students from Pre-Primary to Year 6 will be conducted at Craigie Leisure Centre this term.

DATES: Commence on **Monday 20 May, 2024 to Thursday 30 May, 2024** [9 lessons] (*31 May is a pupil free day*)

TIMES: *Session 1* - 12.00pm-12.45pm Room 1, 3, 7 & 14

Session 2 – 12.45pm-1.30pm Room 8, 10, 13 & 15

Session 3 – 1.30pm-2.15pm Room 5, 9 & 16

COST: All students \$57.00

This charge is for bus travel and pool entry only as the lessons are free. You can pay this amount in instalments if you choose. The full amount must be paid before 17/05/24. Please discuss this option with one of the administration team.

- Swimming lessons payment can be made in cash, EFTPOS or direct deposit via the excursion envelope. Excursion envelopes must have students' FULL name and all details filled out. Students are to return the envelope and the swimming form to the drop box before and after school in the front office. It is essential that all payments are finalised for children to attend swimming lessons by no later than **Friday 17 May, 2023** unless prior arrangements have been made with one of the administration team.
- If a child is known to be subject to any form of medical condition involving periodic loss of consciousness, the child will not be permitted to swim unless a medical certificate is produced by the child's parents stating that it is safe to do so. In case of an emergency the school will contact the parents, an ambulance may be called.
- Where students are unable to continue with lessons, it is possible to refund only the pool entry fee.

CLOTHING & JEWELLERY

- Children may wear their bathers to school with their school uniform over the top or get changed at school.
- Towels and goggles may be carried in a waterproof bag [a plastic shopping bag is suitable].
- Children will get changed into their school uniform back at school.
- Please label children's clothing, bathers, goggles and towels so that misplaced items may be claimed from the lost property.
- Sandals or slip-ons will be permitted to be worn to and from the centre only. Shoes and socks are to be worn at school.
- Students with long hair should have it tied back.
- **No jewellery is to be worn.**

DISCIPLINE

Children are 'sat out' of the water if they don't follow instructions. In extreme cases they are given a warning and are told that after three warnings they will be unable to complete their swimming lessons. School teachers and parents will be notified after a child has received a second warning.

Parents wanting to watch their child swim will be charged a \$2.00 spectator fee per day by Craigie Leisure Centre.
