REASON FOR EXCURSION

COST

NOTE:

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities. Parents/guardians should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property that may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Where it is considered necessary, school staff will arrange medical assessment and treatment for students.
