

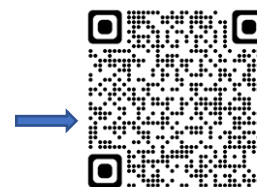
Heathridge Primary School Uniform Policy

The Heathridge Primary School Board has endorsed a school dress code for students when they are attending and representing the school.

The school board believe the dress code:

- Contributes to well-being, comfort and is cost effective for families
- Encourages equity among students.

Hats	School logo bucket hat
Polo shirt	Polo uniform shirt with school logo, coloured faction polo shirt with school logo
HPS Leavers Polo	Royal blue with green panel polo shirt Year 6 students only
Jackets	Royal Blue and green zip-up jacket
Jumper	Royal blue and green poly cotton fleece
Shorts	Royal blue
Skorts	Royal blue skorts (Uniform Concepts) or royal blue yoked skirt (bike pants inside)
Track Pants	Royal blue fleece track pants

Other Considerations:

Footwear	Closed in shoes and socks, sturdy sandals (K-PP) – no thongs/beach sandals
Hair	Hair shoulder length or longer must be tied up and/or clipped back off the face with a simple hair tie, clip or ribbon in school colours
Make-Up	None, clear nail polish is acceptable
Jewellery	The wearing of jewellery is discouraged, watch and stud/sleepers are acceptable
School Bag	Optional – Individual style

Exemptions: An exemption may be granted by the Principal based on unavailability of an item, health, religious beliefs, matters relating to the students cultural background and any other matter which the Principal deems sufficient of exemption.

There will be 'Free Dress Days' during the year.
