REASON FOR EXCURSION / WINTERSPORTS CARNIVAL

Your child has been given the opportunity to represent Heathridge Primary School in the Oceanside School's Winter Sports competition. Students will be competing against students from other local schools in either netball, football or soccer matches.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Games are scheduled to commence at 1.20 pm and will consist of two 20-minute halves with a 10-minute break in between. Games should conclude by 2.20 pm. Students will then return to school and are expected back by 2.50 pm. On the dates that teams have a bye, students not competing will remain at school for a training session with their supervising teacher. Fixtures will be sent home in Term 2. Please note we have a bye in Week 6 due to swimming lessons.

TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

Students will be walking to and from the venues. They will depart Heathridge Primary School at approximately 1.00 pm and will return to school at approximately 2.45 pm.

The venues for the sports are:

Football – Heathridge Park, Sail Tce, Heathridge (approximately 15-minute walk)

Netball – Belridge Senior College (20 minute walk)

Soccer - Eddystone Primary School, Littornia Ave, Heathridge (approximately 20-minute walk)

If parents wish to take their child/children home directly from the venue, you must inform the supervising teacher in lieu of a leave pass.

PARENTS AND CARERS

We invite you to come along and watch your child participate in these games. Parents/Carers are reminded to remain in the designated spectator zone throughout the event. We would be grateful to have some parents/carers to assist with the umpiring at the weekly matches. If you think you can be of assistance, please speak to a member of staff.

SPECIAL CLOTHING OR OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED

All students will need to bring a water bottle, wear full Heathridge Primary School uniform (including a hat) with appropriate shoes. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled. Students in soccer and football will be provided with a team jersey. Students will need to take these home and wash them between games. They remain the property of the school and will be collected in Week 10.

If rain is predicted the event will proceed and students are advised to bring a change of dry clothes and a raincoat. If the weather is extreme, then the event will be cancelled.

OPTION TO OPT-OUT

We understand that the walk to and from the venues, as well as the competitive nature of the Winter Sports program, may place undue pressure on some students. Whilst all children are encouraged to attend, participating in the program is not compulsory and those students who would prefer not to participate will be provided with an alternative learning activity and supervision in a safe space at school. Please inform your classroom teacher if your child will be opting out.

Mrs Sublet, Mrs Davidson and Mr Burdon will be the supervising teachers on the day. Also accompanying them will be special needs education assistants.
