

## **INTERM SWIMMING LESSONS – TERM 2, 2025**

Dear Parents/Carers,

Interm swimming classes for students from Pre-Primary to Year 6 will be conducted at Craigie Leisure Centre this term.

**DATES:** The program will run from Monday, 26 May 2025 to Friday, 6 June 2025, with 8 lessons. Please note, 30 May is a pupil-free day and 2 June is Labour Day.

**TIMES:** Session 1 - 12.00 pm-12.45 pm Rooms 1, 7, 10, 13

Session 2 – 12.45 pm-1.30 pm Rooms 5, 8, 9, 16

Session 3 – 1.30 pm-2.15 pm Rooms 3, 14, 15

**COST: All students \$52.00**

This fee covers only bus travel and pool entry, as the swimming lessons are free. Payment can be made in instalments if preferred, but the full amount must be paid by 21/05/25. If you'd like to arrange instalments, please speak with a member of the administration team.

- Swimming lesson payments can be made via cash, EFTPOS or direct deposit using the excursion envelope. Please ensure the envelope includes the student's full name and all required details. The envelope and swimming form should be returned to the drop box in the front office before or after school. All payments must be completed by Wednesday, 21 May 2025, unless prior arrangements have been made with a member of the administration team.
- If a child is known to be subject to any form of medical condition involving periodic loss of consciousness, the child will not be permitted to swim unless a medical certificate is produced by the child's parents stating that it is safe to do so. In case of an emergency the school will contact the parents, an ambulance may be called.
- Where students are unable to continue with lessons, it is possible to refund only the pool entry fee.
- Should you wish to contact your child or teacher during the lessons, please call the school on tel: 9233 8950.

### **CLOTHING & JEWELLERY**

- Children may wear their bathers to school with their school uniform over the top or get changed at school.
- Towels and goggles may be carried in a waterproof bag.
- Children will get changed into their school uniform back at school.
- Please label children's clothing, bathers, goggles and towels so that misplaced items may be claimed from the lost property.
- Sandals or slip-ons will be permitted to be worn to and from the centre only. Shoes and socks are to be worn at school.
- Students with long hair should have it tied back.
- **No jewellery is to be worn.**

### **DISCIPLINE**

Students who do not follow instructions may be asked to sit out of the water. In more serious cases, a warning system applies—after three warnings, they may not be able to continue their lessons. Parents and teachers will be informed after the second warning.

**Parents wishing to watch their child swim will be required to pay a \$2.00 daily spectator fee, charged by Craigie Leisure Centre.**
